



DIPLOMA IN GENERAL NURSING & MIDWIFERY



G.O (Ms) No. 229 - HFW (PME) Dept dt. 22.9.2006

This course was started in the year 2007 and has an annual Intake of 40 students. This programme is aimed to train students to be the catalyst in the society to prevent diseases, to heal the sick, to take care of the needy and to rehabilitate the affected.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum education eligibility criteria for admission to GNM:

- ★ 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually for any recognized board. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational from ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing council.
- ★ 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/Centre.
- * Registered ANM with pass mark.
- * Admission of students shall be once in a year.
- ★ Students shall be medically fit.
- ★ Minimum age for admission will be 17 years. (as on 31st December of that year) The upper age limit is 35 yrs. For ANM/ for LHV, there is no age bar.
- \bigstar Obtain migration certificate, if having studied from other state.

BASIC B.Sc., (NURSING)



G.O (Ms) No. 38 - HFW (PME) Dept dt. 31.01.2008

This course was started in the year 2008 and has an annual intake of 100 students / Annum from the academic year 2019 - 2020.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.

Minimum education:

- ★ 10+2 class passed with Science (PCB) & English Core/English Elective with aggregate of 45% marks from recognized board under AISSCE / CBSE / ICSE / SSCE / HSCE or other equivalent Board.
- ★ Student shall be medically fit.
- ★ Students appearing in 10+2 examination in Science conducted by National Institute of Open School with 45% marks.
- ★ Students shall be admitted once in a year.
- ★ Obtain migration certificate / eligible certificate, if having studied from other state.

PROGRAMME DURATION





POST BASIC B.Sc., (NURSING)



This course was started in the year 2012 and has an annual intake of 30 students.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ★ Obtained a certificate in General Nursing and Midwifery and registered as R.N.R.M. with the State Nurses Registration Council
- ★ Candidates shall be medically fit.
- * Students shall be admitted once in a year.
- ★ Obtained a certificate in General Nursing and Midwifery and registered as R.N.R.M. with the State Nurses Registration Council.
- ★ Obtain migration certificate, if having studied from other university or state.
- ★ Obtain eligibility certificate from The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University.

PROGRAMME DURATION







This course was started in the year 2012 and has an annual intake of 15 students.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ★ The candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
- ★ The Minimum education requirements shall be the passing of: B.Sc Nursing / B.Sc Hons. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
- ★ The candidate should have undergone in B.Sc Nursing / B.Sc Hons. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc Nursing.
- ★ Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc Nursing.
- ★ Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post asic B.Sc. Nursing.
- ★ Obtain migration certificate, if having studied from other university or state.
- ★ Obtain eligibility certificate from The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University.

PROGRAMME DURATION

FEES

All the students are instructed to make payments in four installments, on time without fail. The fees structure is liable to change at any time, bearing in mind the inflation prevalent in the country. Other fees, if any, will be brought to the notice of candidates on selection.

A student who discontinues the course after admission but before the commencement will not be entitled for refund of the fees already paid to the Institution unless the seat that has fallen vacant due to the discontinuation, is filled up by another candidate. In such case, an account equal to 10% of the total fees payable will be deducted as service charges.

If the student discontinues during the course period for any other reason will have to pay the fees for the remaining period of the course to the Institution.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Lab equipments should be handled carefully.
- While travelling in the college bus, students are expected to maintain proper discipline.
- Students should be in the college sharply at 8.10 a.m. to attend the morning prayer.
- Partens are not allowed to meet their children during the college time without prior permission.
- The students are allowed to attend their own sister's / brother's marriage only. (only oneday)

UNIFORM

- Girls should put up their hair and are permitted to wear only a small ear stud without hanging. No extra jewels allowed.
- Students are not allowed to have long nails and use nail polish, eyetex or such cosmetics.

DRESS CODE FOR THE COLLEGE

Girls can wear only chudidars with shawls pinned up properly.

LIBRARY RULES

- Library will be opened from 9.00 a.m to 5.00 p.m Monday-Friday, 9.00 am to 1.00 p.m on Saturday
- Students must keep their belongings in the designated place, before entering the library.
- Students have to observe absolute silence.
- Students are responsible for the books borrowed against their cards.
- Without borrowers card, books will not be issued to students.
- On losing the borrowers card students should inform the librarian immediately and get a new card by paying of Rs. 25/-.
- Only 2 books can be borrowed at a time for a period not exceeding 3 days or a fine Rs. 5/will be collected for each day after due date.
- Students may renew the books on request at the discretion of the librarian.

- Students should not write in any page or tear the pages of the books.
- Reference books are meant to refer only in the library, journals will not be lent out.
- Damage or loss of books is considered as an offence. Unless the borrower points out the damage at the time of borrowing the books, she shall be liable to replace the book or pay the price of the same.
- Students should not discuss in the library hall, If so the fine of Rs.50/- will be imposed.
- Use of mobile phone is forbidden inside the library.

HOSTEL RULES

- Basic furniture is provided but students are expected to bring their own mattresses, pillows, bed linen and other items of personal use.
- The room and the surroundings should be kept clean and tidy in order to create eco-friendly environment.
- All the students should give the attendance to their hostel warden at 8.45 p.m.
- * Students are not permitted to go out for any reason without prior permission.
- Students must not bring any guests to the room. They may be attended in the visitor's room/common room.
- All electric appliances should be switched off when not required. No room light be on beyond 10.30 pm with take outs.
- All the belongings should be kept under lock and key. Should not keep any valuable things in the room. The management is not responsible for the loss.
- Visitors are allowed to visit the students only on first Sunday of the month from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.
- After 10.30 pm one shall study in mess hall / Mandapam / Front side as per schedule.
- Students are permitted to make phone calls as per schedule.
- Only Authorized visitors, holding the visitors card will be permitted to meet the students.
- Cell phones are strictly prohibited for DGNM & B.Sc(N) students.
- Must utilize the time from 3.30 5.00 p.m. as allotted.
- ♦ Study hours is 6-8 p.m.
